ORDER

Education Department, Chandigarh Administration has 'No Objection' in respect of Northridge International School, Sector 46, Chandigarh for the introduction of classes XI and XII each one section for Humanities, Commerce, Science (Medical and Non-Medical) for the academic session 2026-27 subject to the following conditions:

- i. That the area of the site shall conform to the minimum area prescribed by CBSE;
- ii. That the number of students shall be regulated in accordance with the covered area available with the school and no overcrowding shall be allowed;
- iii. That School will get the status of land upgraded from Estate Office, U.T., Chandigarh,
- iv. That land will be used for the purpose strictly it was originally allotted;
- v. That provisions of RTE Act and the guidelines issued by the UT, Administration/CBSE from time to time will be complied with by school authority in letter and spirit;
- vi. That matter can be reviewed by the Department in case of violation of terms and conditions;
- vii. That all the conditions of land allotment and instructions issued under the provisions of Capital of Punjab (Dev. & Reg.) Act, 1952 are to be followed;
- viii. That admission of 15% EWS students at Sr. Secondary level be made as per land allotment obligatory clause at Sr. No.23 of allotment letter (provisions of Capital of Punjab (Dev. & Reg.) Act, 1952;
- ix. That appointment of teachers must fulfill the qualification as per NCTE guidelines and affiliation board;
- x. That salary is to be paid as per Govt. Norms/7th CPC.
- xi. That School Managing Committee is to be got approved from the Competent Authority.
- xii. That Fire safety norms to be followed meticulously;
- xiii. That all the conditions as per Recognition order are to be followed.
- xiv. That the school shall obtain all necessary approvals/affiliation from the CBSE before commencing the Senior Secondary Classes and shall comply with all the norms and regulation and instructions issued by the Education Deptt. And CBSE from time to time.
- xv. That the issuance of NOC shall not be construed as a grant of affiliation by CBSE, and the school shall independently fulfill all the requirement prescribed by the concerned board before starting the proposed classes.
